## The NO FLUSH Zone



Avoid flushing these items down toilets, sinks, bathtub/showers, garbage disposals or other drains. These items could lead to damaging grinder pumps, clogs leading to backups onto homeowner property and problems at the local treatment plant. These issues are costly to the homeowner and municipality. Refer to the product instructions on how to properly dispose of that item to prevent harm to the environment.
